Vilnius Open Chess Championship 2024

1. ORGANISATION

3 main events will take place: A (elite standard); B (amateur standard); C (children standard).

In addition, a **D** (MRU Blitz) tournament and evening E (chess variants) tournaments will be held.

Date - 29 July - 04 August, 2024.

2. PARTICIPANTS

All chess players are invited to participate. Maximum sum of total A and B tournament participants – 120.

- GM, IM, WGM, WIM no entry fee.
- FM, CM, WFM, WCM get a 50% discount (in tournaments A, B and D).
- Other players whose FIDE standard chess rating is higher than 2200 get a 20% discount (tournaments A, B).
- Chess players whose FIDE standard chess rating is lower than 2000 but not lower than 1800 may participate in A tournament with an entry fee of 100€.
- Vilnius Chess Club members get an additional 10€ discount (tournaments A, B, C).

3. FORMAT

A, B and C tournaments will be held using Swiss System by FIDE Standard chess laws, D tournament – using Swiss System by FIDE Blitz chess laws. FIDE ratings will be calculated.

The winner is determined by who scores the most points. In case of a tie, places will be determined based on these tiebreakers:

- 1. Median-Buchholz coefficient (minus the score of the worst opponent);
- 2. Full Buchholz coefficient;
- 3. Progress coefficient;
- 4. Berger coefficient.

4. REGISTRATION

Registration to tournaments A, B and C is held **until 14 July 2024 included**, via an email to the CA Andrius Paulauskas (<u>andrius.paulauskas96@gmail.com</u>) with a CC to the Director Kipras Eigminas (<u>kipras.eigminas@gmail.com</u>).

Should the maximum number of players be reached, the registration may end early. After the deadline, the entry fee is increased by 50%.

Please specify FIDE ID and the represented city when registering. Should a Lithuanian participant not be registered by FIDE, an email and **full** birth date must be provided. Foreign players must contact their national federations to acquire the FIDE ID.

Should a participant have special needs, please inform the organisers during the registration.

5. PAYMENT

The entry fee for A, B, C tournaments (non-refundable) is paid via a bank transfer before the end of the registration. Fees of tournaments D and E are paid in cash at the venue.
